The April issue of *narfe* magazine reported that a strategic planning process has been defined for NARFE and both a Strategic Planning Team and Strategic Planning Committee have been appointed. We would like to take this opportunity to share that at the March 2015 National Executive Board meeting, 12 items were identified for initial review by the Strategic Planning Committee in the next few months. Others have been deferred to later strategic planning committees. Here are the 12 items:
